We have all of the tools, equipment, and skilled people to install as many wells as we would like. We install the wells next to a church where the local congregation can look after it and plan for the regular maintenance. This is very important because when a well goes in, they begin to count on it. And that's not a bad thing.

Currently, we have enough resources for just a couple of wells, and we would love to see what God has in store if we would all be faithful. Out of the blessings that we receive, we have the opportunity to make a real difference in this world. And there is nothing more satisfying in my life than making a difference.

We have a unique opportunity to help a large group of people in Chad. There is a coalition of villages that has made an urgent request for water wells. They have heard of the great work that we have been doing in other
